Today, as we celebrate the great feast of the Most Holy Trinity we are reminded of the life to which we have been called.

God's unity is revealed by his Son, Jesus Christ who sent the Holy Spirit so that we might share in that unity and offer it to others through baptism.

When we are baptised in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, we are welcomed into God's life of grace which is poured out on the whole world bringing unity and peace, dignity and meaning to our lives.

Just as God is one in three persons, so we, the Church, the Body of Christ are one in his love and united to him.

SOLEMNITY OF SAINT BONIFACE Patron of the Diocese of Plymouth

On Friday this week (5 June) we celebrate the feast of St Boniface.

For the first forty years of his life Boniface was known as Wynfrith. He was born in Devon and educated at the monastery at Exeter, and then joined the Benedictine abbey at Nursling, near Southampton. He was a teacher and preacher, but he desired to preach the gospel in a foreign land. In 718, Pope Gregory II commissioned him to do so, at the same time changing his name from Wynfrith to Boniface. Boniface left England, never to return, and took the gospel to the heathen tribes of Germany, where he had great success. He himself was created Bishop of Mainz, and he founded or restored dioceses in Bavaria, Thuringia, and Franconia. In his later years he worked with King Pepin the Short to reform the Frankish church, and then, over seventy years old, set out to evangelize Friesland (part of modern Holland) where he was set upon and murdered, on 5 June 754. He is buried at Fulda, near Frankfurt, in the monastery he founded himself.
