

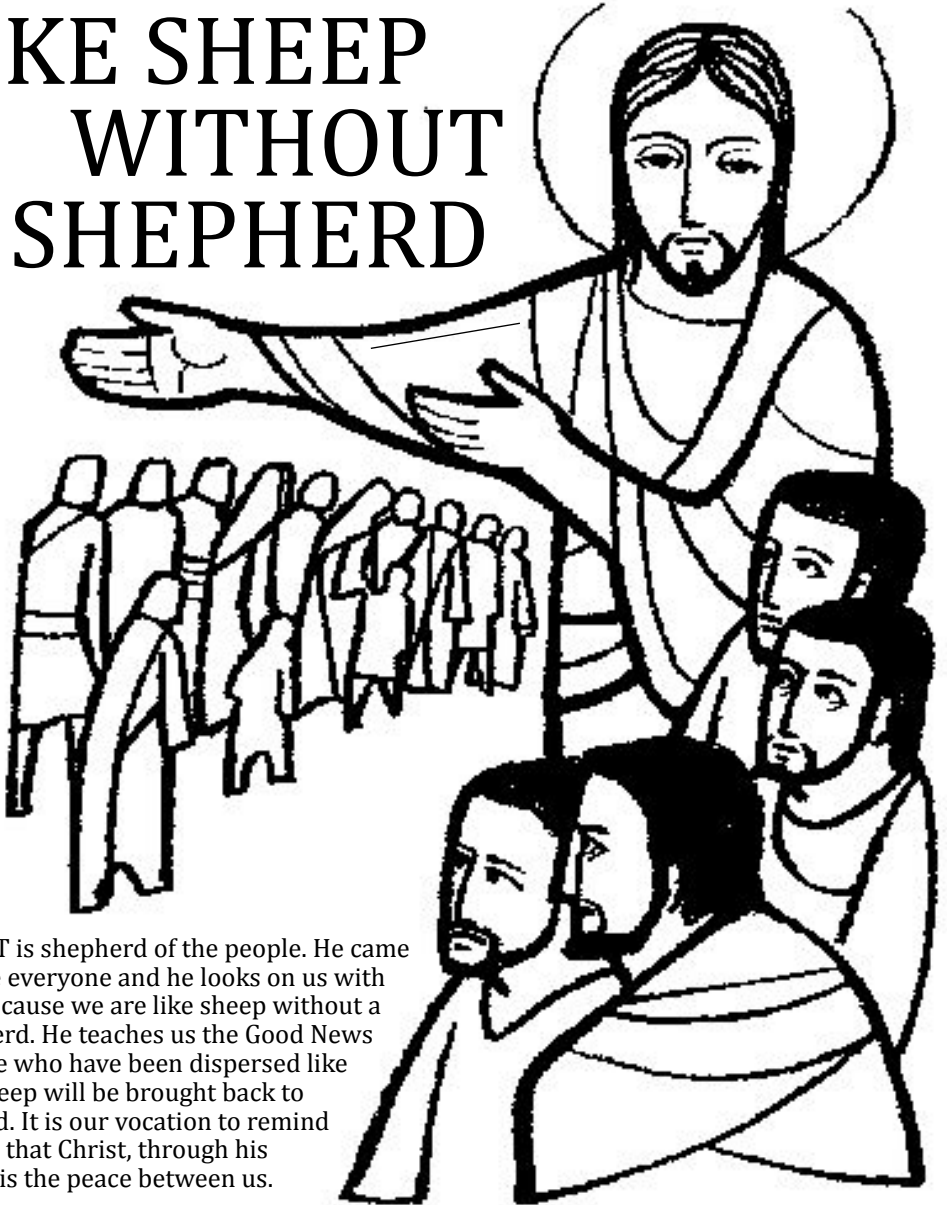

## THE SOCIETY OF ST VINCENT DE PAUL

More than 6 million adults live in absolute poverty in Britain. This means they are destitute and are deprived of basic human needs such as food, sanitation, health or shelter. But poverty isn't the only sort of deprivation; chronic loneliness and isolation is a significant and growing problem. According to the Office of National Statistics, Britain has become the loneliness capital of Europe. Even here in our own parish poverty and isolation are prevalent, but what can we do about it? This weekend at all Masses the St Vincent de Paul Society will explain how we can work together to take action. This was one of the objectives identified by the PPC from the recent parish survey as a way of reaching out to those in need.
