





#### Safeguarding and Reporting Absences

Parents are required to inform the school of the reason for a child's absence before 9.00am on the day of the absence. This can be done at any time by leaving a message on 01626 773905 or by e-mail [office@olsp-rc.devon.sch.uk](mailto:office@olsp-rc.devon.sch.uk)

Parents should telephone the school on the first day of absence. Parents of children whose absences are still unexplained by 10am will be telephoned on all contact numbers provided to the school. If school staff are unable to make contact with Parent/Carers, and no explanation of the child's whereabouts is obtained, the school will contact the local community police who will undertake a "safeguarding attendance" sweep of the child's given address. We wish to ensure the safety of children, especially for older year 5 and 6 children who may walk to school on their own. Please therefore help us in keeping us fully informed of absences from school.



## Nursery Admissions

Children are welcome to start in our Nursery from the term after their 3<sup>rd</sup> birthday. We are currently welcoming applications for September 2016. The deadline for applications for this intake is **27<sup>th</sup> May 2016**. If you would like to come and visit our school please make an appointment via the school office.

## Keeping us informed -Contact and Medical details

Please remember to keep us up to date with contact details plus any medical issues and/or medication. Although we do try to check dates on prescribed medication retained at school and endeavour to keep our lovely parents informed, the school nurse team has advised it is a parental responsibility to ensure medication and asthma inhalers supplied to us are in date. ## Parking

**Please do not park or drop off at the bottom of the driveway** and please do not park on the Zigzag lines outside the school or in the bus bay as these areas are particularly dangerous. Do please be mindful when dropping off and collecting your children by car; be especially careful not to block in any driveways surrounding the school. Also, please make sure you let your children out of the vehicle kerb side rather than into the road. We truly appreciate your cooperation and understanding of this.
