





Sharing Sunday’s Gospel

I expect many of us can think of a time when we were fighting or disagreeing with someone and how that felt. Or perhaps we can remember a time when other people were arguing near us and how that made us feel.

It is really lovely though to then remember a time when we stopped fighting with someone and made friends with them again and how good that felt, or when the argument near us ended and the people forgave each other. Each time we feel distant from God, be assured that God is very close to us, wanting us to be filled with his peace.

If children learn to play peacefully together when they are young, then they will hopefully also be able to work or play peacefully together when they are adults, and we can try hard to model this for them. We can all help here at OLSP to build peace in our community. Jesus gives us all the gift of peace. He tells us all not to be worried or upset because he will always be there for us. When he went back to his Father he sent the Holy Spirit to help us live peacefully in His way. We are doing this when we do our best to share peace with others. I wonder how we can help to share the gift of peace in our community and around the world in the coming weeks?
