## This week's Gospel Reading

This Sunday we hear about a dishonest steward and about how we cannot love God and money equally. On Monday, we will be talking to the children about how God must come first in our lives as well as discussing with them the need to be careful with how we spend and share our money or possessions. This is a lovely theme for us to explore in the lead up to our Harvest Breakfast and Assembly on Tuesday morning.

A steward is someone who looks after money, property or other valuable things. The steward in this story looked after a rich man's property and money. I wonder why the rich man was cross with his steward? I wonder how you would feel if you owed a friend some money and they only asked for some of the money back?

Would you do the same for anyone you know?

We will be thinking about what we can do to help make sure all people, here and around the world, have what they need to live. We are all stewards of this world but also of each other so we need to look after both people and the earth, wisely and fairly.

Jesus says that if we can't be trusted in small things we won't be trusted with bigger things. Perhaps you might like to talk in your family this week about what small things are important to you and why? What big things are important to you and why? Also maybe about how can you be careful with all of them.

Jesus says we can't serve both God and money in our lives. God must come first. Then other people. Then money and possessions last. When you think about what's important to you, which comes first, your friends and family, including our brothers and sisters around the world? Or your toys and clothes and other things? It's a tough answer for many of us to face.

**How will you make sure that you put God and other people before your possessions in the coming week? What will you do to show that you serve God in your life?**
