

Real Easter Egg

The people behind the Real Easter Egg have launched a competition for schools, Sunday schools and messy churches. There will be a prize of £250 for the winner with runner-up prizes of £150 for second placed entries. The winners will each also receive a special edition Real Easter Egg.

The Real Easter Egg is all about sharing the Easter story so the challenge is to draw what happened, according to the Bible, on Easter Sunday.

This year a 24 page Easter story-activity book illustrated by Alida Massari is included in the Original Egg Hunt and Dark eggs. The Special Edition has a Easter traditions booklet inside. The Sharing box, with 30 eggs, comes with 30 colour-in posters.

Out of the 80 million Easter eggs sold in this part of the world every year, The Real Easter Egg is the only one which has a copy of the Easter story in the box, is made of Fairtrade chocolate and makes a donation to charity from sales.
