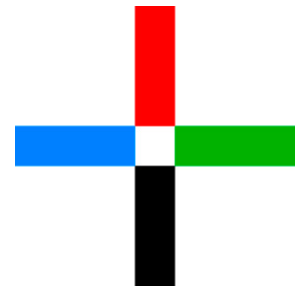

Be inspired by speakers Bishop Mark, Libby Abbott of CAFOD and Nick Hanrahan of the Jesuit Refugee Service UK.

The ‘Share the Journey’ Exhibition, as first shown in the Houses of Parliament, will be at Buckfast Abbey for two weeks from 27th April until 13th May. ## A weekend for Transformation and Mission

This new format prayer festival was established at Buckfast Abbey in Devon in 2017. The aim of the event, called 'Run to the Son', is specifically to equip Catholics for the urgent task of evangelisation. As Michele Thompson, co-organiser of the weekend says, "there is a lot of talk about the need for evangelisation and that's good, but we wanted to create something which will actually give people what they need to go out and do it"

Bishop Mark writes: "We will be spending time together the weekend **22nd-24th June 2018**, to deepen our encounter with Jesus, the Son of God, who brings real purpose and meaning to our lives. So many in our society and culture do not know Him, or the beauty of an encounter with Him. Some have walked away from our faith without knowing that it is within the Church that we experience and grow in our love of Him. Do come, and learn with others, how we can make many more, His disciples."

# PARISH SECRETARY


