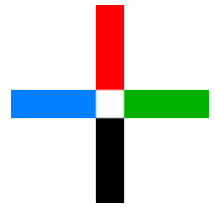

WORLD COMMUNICATIONS DAY – 2018

The Catholic Church celebrates World Communications Day on 13 May 2018.

This is a day when we pray for those who work in the media, and have a second collection after Mass to support the Church's important work in this area. Pope Francis, in his message for World Communications Day, focuses on 'Fake News and Journalism for Peace'.

In the message 'La Verita Vi Fara Liberi' – "The truth will set you free" (Jn 8:32), the Pope begins: *"Made in the image and likeness of our Creator, we are able to express and share all that is true, good, and beautiful. We are able to describe our own experiences and the world around us, and thus to create historical memory and the understanding of events. But when we yield to our own pride and selfishness, we can also distort the way we use our own ability to communicate."*
