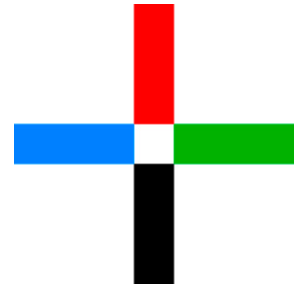

You may have noticed from recent newsletters that there is quite a lot happening at Buckfast Abbey. This is particularly because during 2018 the abbey is celebrating its Millennium Year. Although the current abbey is relatively modern, a monastery has continued to be situated at Buckfast since the first Benedictine monks settled, during the reign of King Canute in 1018.
